



Introducing the MBA dual-award programme







Admission criteria

You have a very good chance of being admitted to the MBA dual-award programme, if you have the following:

- an undergraduate degree in business and management or similar subject from an university (180 ECTS credits)
- or an undergraduate degree in another discipline with interest in business and/or entrepreneurship (please upload your CV in your application)
- English proficiency test e.g. IELTS at level 6.5 (if you do not have IELTS, but can demonstrate that you have used English in your work, we may be able to waive the IELTS requirement).

Visa process

The process for getting the residence permit is as follows:

After we have processed your application, we will send you a preliminary admission letter and an invoice for the first two terms (EUR 14.500) of your total tuition fees if you meet the entry requirements. The remaining will be due in future semesters. Once we have received the first payment, we will send you the official admission letter which you can use to apply for the residence permit in Finland.

In addition to paying the first tuition fee installment in advance, you will need to demonstrate to the Finnish authorities that you have a sufficient amount of money to meet your living costs. For a two-year stay, you must have EUR 13.440 at your disposal. If you only want the residence permit for one year at a time, you must have EUR 6.720 in your bank account.

Should your residence permit application be declined we will refund in full the tuition fee you have paid.
